The two leading candidates in the Texas lieutenant gubernatorial election will appear on **Texas Lieutenant Governor Debate 2014**, on Monday, September 29 at 7:00 p.m. CT.

The one-hour live debate between state Senator Dan Patrick, R-Houston, and state Senator Leticia Van de Putte, D-San Antonio, will be available unrestricted and free of charge, for broadcast on television, radio and streaming online.

The Texas Association of Broadcasters is funding the television satellite distribution of this debate in order that stations may air the broadcast as a public service or use portions in news coverage.

The broadcast will feature real-time Spanish language translation and real-time closed captioning. It will be produced jointly by KLRU-TV, Austin PBS and The Texas Tribune. Other production partners include TAB and Univision Austin.
